Website Updates



Corporate Rail







New Smooth Bottom Panel

To bring all Smooth Bottom panels to a "truer" height for ALL grades we have adjusted the rail placement on the **Commercial** and **Industrial** panels slightly as shown on the attached CAD example.

New jobs will not be affected. However, if you are trying to match a job that was built prior to November 7, 2023 with a "replacement" panel or possibly an "add on" this should be noted on the order form when placing orders. The Customer Service team has been screening all orders accordingly as they are received but we wanted to provide you with additional information and support with the CADs to assist going forward. Accounting Software Update Effective April 1st 2024

For those customers that are not sales tax exempt, please be advised that beginning April 1st, Antebellum will be using new software to calculate sales tax. Due to this change, it is necessary that payments be made based on the information on the Invoice, and not the Sales Order; particularly if the Sales Order is dated prior to April 1st. Similarly, Antebellum is legally required to collect sales tax based on the delivery address; therefore, if the delivery address is changed, payment must be made based on the updated Invoice. Lastly, if your order is subject to discretionary (county or otherwise) sales surtax limits, the software will apply those limits; however, the total sales tax due will be calculated in one lump sum and Antebellum will no longer have the ability to separate sales tax into the line items showing state and discretionary tax.
